

WASTE MANAGEMENT POLICY

Waste Management includes waste-related production, separation, storage, transportation and source point (region/department) with waste, such as transportation to the final disposal site (recycling/landfill/incinerator) It covers all related activities.

This policy includes the classification of all waste generated as a result of SEGER activities, Responsibilities regarding separation, collection, storage, transportation and disposal It covers SEGER's regulations, including

This Policy applies to all services provided by SEGER and all employees Responsible for knowing, understanding and implementing the policy.

This Policy also applies to all suppliers of SEGER.

With this approach;

- SEGER always ensures full regulatory compliance for its Waste Management activities, ensuring the best possible performs applications.
- Determines all kinds of emergency precaution plans related to Waste Management activities and works to reduce risks.
- Identifies risks and opportunities related to waste management activities and eliminates hazards and minimizes risks engages in downloading activities.
- Works to reduce environmental impacts.
- Controls are carried out for all Waste Management activities and it is ensured that security is present.
- Materials are recycled and reused whenever possible and practical.
- Efforts are made to eliminate or minimize waste through product and process design and development activities.
- All wastes generated on site or materials that will ultimately be treated as waste are disposed of in accordance with the legislation are identified, parsed and stored. It is given to licensed organizations for disposal.
- Emergency response equipment is kept ready in waste storage areas.
- Controls of waste storage areas are carried out periodically.
- Improvement activities are carried out to reduce packaging waste in our value chain.
- All employees must comply with the Waste Policy and environmental procedure.
- Accidents, near misses and situations against policy are reported to the Integrated System Manager.
- All employees carry out waste reduction, minimization and recycling activities in their own areas/departments. Actively participates in and supports initiatives.
